### 1. **Coca-Cola Scholars Scholarship Program-**

**Who's Eligible?** Awarded based on character, personal merit and commitment. Merit is demonstrated through leadership in school, civic and extracurricular activities, academic achievement, and motivation to serve and succeed.

**Amount?** Every year 250 achievement-based scholarships are awarded. Fifty (50) awards are for \$20,000 payable over a four-year period. The other 200 awards are for \$10,000, also payable over a four-year period.

**Deadline-** Apply online at [www.coca-colascholars.org](http://www.coca-colascholars.org) before October 31, 2009

### 2. **Elks National Foundation Legacy Award –**

**Who's Eligible?** If you are a child or grandchild of a living Elk who is a member in good standing, you are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

**Amount?** Four-year, \$4,000 scholarship

**Where Can Applications be accessed?** The Legacy Award application is available only online at [www.elks.org/enf/scholars](http://www.elks.org/enf/scholars) and must be submitted online.

**Deadline-** January 8, 2010

3. **Elks National Foundation 2009 Most Valuable Student Scholarship –**

**Who's Eligible?-** Any student may apply for this scholarship.

**Amount?-** Over two million dollars is given out in 500 scholarships.

**Where Can Applications be accessed?-** From the guidance office or online [www.elks.org/enf/scholars](http://www.elks.org/enf/scholars) Online applications must be downloaded, printed, and mailed when completed.

**Deadline-** November 2, 2009

4. **New York State Elks Association Scholarship –**

**Who's Eligible?-** This scholarship is for a child of an Elk member in good standing. There are no other qualifications other than parental relationships.

**Amount?-** \$1,000

**Where Can Applications be accessed?-** From the guidance office or online [www.elks.org/enf/scholars](http://www.elks.org/enf/scholars) Online applications must be downloaded, printed, and mailed when completed.

**Deadline-** November 2, 2009

5. **New York Water Environment Association- The New York Water Environment Association will be offering a total of six \$1,500 scholarships.**

- Two (2) to children of NYWEA members.
- Two (2) to students enrolled at a college or university (listed below) where there is a NYWEA student chapter
- Two (2) to high school students who will be enrolled in an environmentally related program in a four year college or university.

**Scholarship - Children of NYWEA Members**

Two \$1,500 scholarships are available for children of NYWEA Members.

Eligibility Requirements:

- A parent or student who has been a member in good standing of the NYWEA for at least one year.
- The applicant must enroll as a full-time student in an environmentally related program that allows them to pursue a professional career in the environmental field.

- High school senior and must enroll at a college or university by September 2010, or a freshman in good standing at a college or university and will begin the sophomore year by September 2010.

### **Scholarship - NYWEA Student Members**

- Two \$1,500 scholarships are available for student members who attend a college or university, with a NYWEA student chapter such as:
  - Brooklyn College-CUNY New York City
  - City College, Civil Engineering Dept.
  - Clarkson University, Potsdam
  - Cooper Union, NYC
  - Hofstra University, Hemstead
  - Manhattan College, NYC
  - New York Institute of Technology, NYC
  - Polytechnic University
  - Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Troy
  - Stony Brook University, SUNY, Stonybrook
  - SUNY College of Environmental Science & Forestry, Syracuse
  - University of Buffalo, SUNY, Buffalo.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- A student enrolled in a college or university that has a NYWEA student chapter.
- The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in an environmentally related program that allows them to pursue a professional career in the environmental field.
- A student in good standing at a college or university and will begin the Sophomore, Junior or Senior year by September 2010.

### **Scholarship - High School Students Pursuing Environmental Studies**

Two \$1,500 scholarships are available for high school students who will be enrolled in an environmentally related program in a four year college.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- High School Senior in good standing, who has applied to a college or university with the interest of pursuing an environmental career.
- Student winner must show proof of enrollment in the environmentally related program at the four year college or university in September 2010 to receive a scholarship check.

**Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline is January 21, 2010**

#### **6. Dr. Seuss's Oh, the Places You'll Go! College Scholarship**

**About-** Dr. Seuss's Oh, the Places You'll Go! College Scholarship recognizes a high school senior who understands and values the limitless possibilities that education can offer with a scholarship award.

**Award-** First Place: \$5,000  
-One Scholarship Awarded

**Who can enter-** Applicants must be 12<sup>th</sup>-grade high school students graduating spring 2010, age 21 years or under.
