1. **Buffalo Urban League Scholarship-** Scholarship awardees are selected based on their academic achievement, community service, character, and financial need. Students are required to write an essay and provide at least one letter of recommendation (three letters of recommendation are required to qualify for a 4 year scholarship). All graduating high school students and are eligible to apply! You do not need to live in Buffalo! In 2009 awards ranged from \$250.00 one time scholarships to \$4,000.00 multi-year scholarships.

Applications are available in the guidance office. Completed applications must be postmarked by March 15, 2010.

2. **2010 Jonathan Teuscher Scholarship-** Established by Steven and Donna Teuscher in memory of their son Jonathan. This scholarship is to be awarded to a graduate who has faced challenges while maintaining a positive attitude, with an award for each year of continued education. **Applications are available in the guidance office. Applications must be turned in to the guidance office by April 1, 2010.**

3. **Pat McGee Scholarship-** This scholarship in memory of former State Senator Pat McGee will seeks to carry on the Senator's mission of improving life in the Southern Tier. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be available to students in Senate district 57 who **intend to pursue nursing**, at any school, through the Community Foundation. Students must maintain at least a C average in order to be eligible for this award. **Applications are available in the guidance office. Applications must be turned in to the guidance office by April 1, 2010.**

4. **John J. Murphy Family Scholarship-** This award is available to Olean area students and students whose family members are employed by or have retired from Dresser Rand in Olean. This is a \$10,000 scholarship, with \$2,500 awarded per year for four years. **Preference will be given to applicants indicating their intention to pursue Bachelor Degrees or higher in nursing, engineering or business.**

Selection criteria shall include scholastic achievement, school and community participation, demonstrated leadership potential and financial need. **Applications are available in the guidance office. Applications must be turned in to the guidance office by April 1, 2010.**

5. **Olean Business Institute / McCarthy Scholarship**- Available to a student who plans to attend OBI pursuing a degree in business. **Applications are available in the guidance office. Applications must be turned in to the guidance office by April 1, 2010.**
6. **Civil Engineering / Land Surveying Scholarship**- E&M Engineers and Surveyors PC, Springville Office is please to announce its fourth annual scholarship award of \$1,000.00.

To be eligible for consideration, the following criteria will be used to select a high school senior:

- Student must intend to enroll in a program in the **fields of Civil Engineering or Land Surveying; however, other engineering degrees will also be considered.**
- Student must submit a 200 word (minimum) essay stating why you think Civil Engineering or Land Surveying are important professions and why you would like to enter the field.
- Student must provide a letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or principal.

All applications will be kept confidential and must be received at E&M Engineers and Surveyors Springville office **no later than April 30, 2010. Applications are available in the guidance office.**

7. **2010 Tylenol Scholarship**- Scholarships awarded to students pursuing **healthcare-related** education.
 - Ten students will be awarded \$10K scholarships
 - Thirty students will receive \$5K grants
 - **Applications must be received by May 14, 2010.**Visit www.tylenol.com and click on "2010 Tylenol Scholarship" to apply.
8. **Ancient Order of Hibernians Scholarship**- An award of \$1,000 will be awarded to two (2) qualified Cattaraugus County high school graduates of the class of 2009-2010. The criteria to be eligible for the scholarship are you must:
 - be Irish by ancestry or by birth
 - be the son or daughter of a member in good standing of the A.O.H. Cattaraugus County Division II
 - graduate high school at the conclusion of the 2009-2010 school year
 - graduate from a Cattaraugus County high school
 - be accepted to a college
 - demonstrate (exemplify) Roman Catholic values.

Applications are available in the guidance office. The deadline for the application is June 5, 2010.
